Accountability Review

Accountability includes learning and accepting what the appropriate consequence(s) of our behavior is/are. Accountability is *not* collusion or punishment. This Accountability Review helps you decide on appropriate consequences. Before deciding on consequences, please consider the following.

GROUP ACCOUNTABILITY GUIDELINES

Collusion: A response which "protects" the person in question, is less (or none at all) than the severity of the behavior and is intended to, or has the effect to, strengthen male privilege.

Accountable Consequences: A response which educates in relation to the behavior, matches the severity of the behavior and seeks to reduce male privilege.

Punishment: A response "at the expense" of the person in question which is greater than the severity of the behavior and is intended to, or has the effect to, strengthen male privilege.
